


## Plant commentary September Meeting Best overall and best in Second Division Valley Champion 'Superstar' Grown by Adrian Bockmann

This is one of the best feathered cymbidiums available. It is a vey attractive soft pink with strong and even feathering. The flowers are a very good shape and well displayed on the spike. It had 5 spikes with 6 to 11 flowers pe spike. All flowers were fresh and open. It was a most attractive and striking cymbidium.

A little more on this lovely cymbidium. It was a mutation from another Valley Champion variety. One plant from a batch of cones, grown by Pioneer Orchids, at Leopold (near Geelong), mutated and was quite different to other clones in the flasks. Brenton McGee, the proprietor identified it immediately, and grew it on and identified it as being a stable mutation, when it flowered consistently year after year. He offered a small division on eBay, and it sold for a very high price. Other divisions were later offered for sale, but only after each division bloomed. It was originally sold under the trade name of Pioneer Flash 'Superstar', also Valley Champion 'Flash' (confusing), but was later name changed to it's correct name of Valley Champion 'Superstar' (Valley Splash x Valley Regent). There are some plants still being labelled with the incorrect name. It is a very strong grower, and there are limited numbers of plants of it becoming available, but still at premium prices. If it is cloned, there is a strong possibility that the clones may not flower like Superstar, but until some flower who knows?? It has won major prizes at interstate shows already. It is a very exciting plant of the future.

## Best in Open Division Memoria Amelia Earhart x Pacific Sparkle Grown by John Moon

This plant flowered on a very small plant (typical of Mem Amelia Earhars progeny). It had two green bulbs and two new leads, and one pendulous flower spike with 13 fully open flowers. The colour was caramel, with a very dark solid red labellum. It was a nicely grown plant, in a 125mm pot, in a mixture of 8 to 10mm bark, and perlite
