Below is part of an Email from Norm Martin (COCSA Speaker last year), reporting on how he uses the pool algicide Purex, to treat cymbidiums suffering from bulb rot.

Hi Helmuth,

It's great to hear from you. Yes, Alginox is the chemical. I use Alginox as a contact control for fungal and bacteria attack at a rate of 2mls per litre. But be careful of flowering plants, as it will damage the flowers. You can flush it through your pots and spray the surrounding areas as a control for slugs and snails. You can make it stronger if you don't get it on the plants. I also use it at about 25% strength to treat bulb rot (just on the rotten section).

I hope this helps.

Hello Graham!

Letter to and from Norm Martin, Finally I can see the light at the end of the tunnel. Purex is available from Lonsdale Carpet & Pool Supply on O'Sullivan Beach Road for a few \$\$\$.

It is also sold under different labels, so check that the main chemical is BENZALKONIUM.

It is a versatile compound, used in medical, health, personal and industrial cleaning products. (one litre of pool algicide treats a 20000 litre pool. All I need now are plenty of SLUGS to carry out test. Regards Helmuth. (From the Editor. Helmuth has had a big slug problem in the past, but is now getting on top of it)

Over the years, many members have used Purex as a preventative and a treatment in the fight against bulb rot. At the worst, many plants showing bulb rot will die. Not much to lose by using it.. Quickly isolate any plants with bulb rot. Many growers bag plants before moving them

Alan & Miriam Merriman publish a regular newsletter giving growing advice for orchids of all type. It is titled Alan & Miriam's Newsletter, and is published very regularly. Contact Alan on 0439 514 141 or email miriannorchids@pnc.com.au to be added to the mailing list.

Below is an extract from the July 2017 magazine, and refers to treatment for plants with bulb rot.

The most common would have to be the dreaded bulb rot, commonly called the "Brown Rot". Most bulbous plants will eventually succumb to this disease that attacks the top of the bulb and then goes down into the bulb to rot it away. Once noticed, stop watering. Keep plant on the dry side. The main control agent is to use one of the Phosphorus acids. They come in different strengths so look at the label. Must use with a wetter, not a oil!! This will help control a lot of bulb and root rots. Other controls include ALIETTE and RIDOMIL. For rates on use of Aliette on orchids see Alan's Pests and Disease Handbook page 63.

Many growers over the years have used many strains of TRICHODERMA. TRI-D25 is one of the main strains that is used. Spray 150g of TRI-D25 per 100 L of water. This should cover 40sq.metres every 2-3 weeks preferable late afternoon.

All plants must be clean and virus free or the judges or show marshal will reject them. The judge's decisions are final. Should any protest be lodged, the show marshal will call a panel to give a decision-

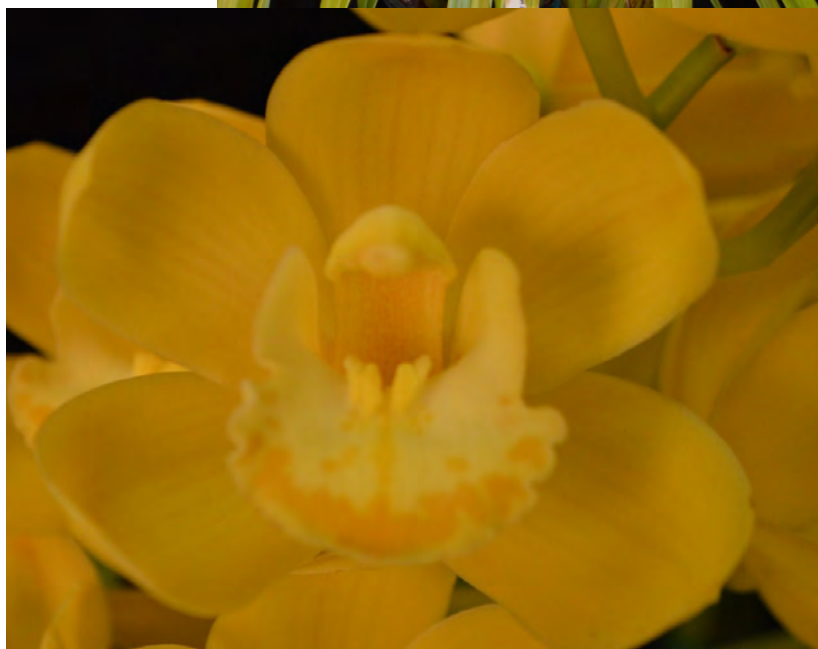

Plant descriptions June meeting

Best in Open Division Pharaoh's Dream

Grown by Ben Knobben

This plant was judged as a Pure Colour. It was an intermediate sized flower, growing in a 200mm pot, with 4 flower spikes, and a total of 46 bright yellow flowers. There were five green bulbs and two new leads. It was growing in medium sized bark

Best in First Division Gypsy Rose 'Mini TeePee'

Grown by Shane Moeller

This was a beautifully presented plant. It was growing in a 170mm pot, with four fully out flower spikes. The blooms were well above the foliage, and there was a nice colour contrast in the lip. This plant had been grown very well

Best in Second Division (Sue x Beaconfire)

Grown by Glenn Stearnes

This plant was growing in a 170mm pot, with 8 green bulbs, and 6 backbulbs. There were 4 flower spikes, two of 13 flowers each, and two with 11 flowers.

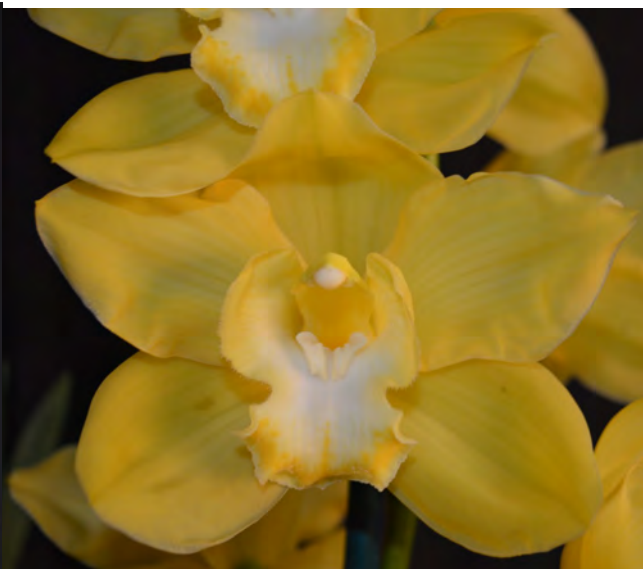
