Training of Judges in 2018. Max Kahlbaum

In recent years the pool of club judges available for our meetings and shows has fallen away to a critical point where we increasingly struggle to fill the panels required during the year, and the workload falls on fewer and fewer members.

If the Club's present approach to its competitive activity is to continue, then somehow we need to grow this pool of judges. Failing this, we may have to consider introducing some form of "popular" voting done by members rather than by judges?

As well, consideration is being given to adopting a 2018 judging roster for all our meetings and shows so that we can better understand where our needs are and help spread the workload around.

The Committee is now offering a basic one-year training course, commencing on 16th (or 17th) of April this year, for any members willing to train as club judges.

Brief Details

- 4x theory/practice monthly workshops (2 hours each), generally in the evenings at Burnside, but venues open to some negotiation.
- Intensive/practical experience at club meetings (5x) and shows (2x) all with the assistance of experienced judges.

Upon successful completion of this course and in consultation with the Registrar, trainees could expect to be approved as qualified club judges for 2019 and beyond.

Registration forms will be available at our AGM on 28th February.

JUDGING of SEEDLINGS . Ben Knobben

When we judge seedlings, we look for the same qualities as for all plants, such as shape and substance, colour and texture, habit and arrangement in the flowers. However, seedlings have no restrictions on the number of flowers, therefore it doesn't need seven flowers on a spike to qualify.

The most important consideration when judging a seedling is **POTEN-TIAL**. Also, all the flowers should be open, and should a flower be broken off in transit, it should be presented with the plant.

PS.

With potential in mind, I am rather concerned at a trend that has developed where I have a load of seedlings in 8 inch pots. They are very large plants and don't look anything like seedlings. I have spoken to other members who also have noticed this happening with their plants. The definition of a seedling is an immature plant, but some of the seedlings spiking at the moment, look more like cabbages.

Hopefully the flowers will look a million dollars.
