Plant write-ups – Orchid Spectacular 21st to 23rd August 2015
Grand Champion, and Champion Large Standard – Kimberley Splash
“TeePee”

, a magnificently grown plant, by David Wain, from Melbourne

This plant had 2 big, upright flower spikes, with 15 and 12 flowers per spike. The colour was a bold off white, overlaid with bold strong pink splashing, a bit reminiscent of one of it's parents Valley Splash “Awesome”. This was a very eye-catching plant, which had it's photograph taken and shared, by large numbers of enthusiastic visitors to the show. Pictures of it were put onto our Facebook site, and there were a very large number of visitors to our site (2264 to date), with 135 saying they liked it, and 34 sharing it with other Facebook members. It is a very popular and admired plant. It was awarded an Award of Merit (AM), by our judges. This is a high level award. Congratulations David.

Champion Novelty, and Champion Intermediate – Drouin Masterpiece
“ Kaleidoscope”,

grown beautifully by Andy Tran, from Melbourne

This plant had multiple, upright flower spikes. It had a lovely yellow background, with delicate orange splashing, extending outwards from the centre of the flower. This plant is a valuable and very desirable mutation, from another Drouin Masterpiece clone, which occasionally occurs during the cloning process. Some growers love this type of plant, while others are not so keen on it. It was awarded an Award of Distinction (AD) and a Highly Commended Certificate (HCC) by the judges. This is a plant which many other growers would have loved to have taken home. Unfortunately mutated and flared varieties, most often do not clone reliably, and usually flower different to the mother plant. If you want a piece of this plant, you will need to get a division of the original plant, not a clone of it.

Champion Small Standard – Prized “Symbol”

This was a lovely glowing orange plant, with a lovely complimentary labellum, with 12 flowers on an upright flower spike. For anyone who attended the show, please note – this plant was originally exhibited as Kalahari Pepper x Lunar Fury. Unfortunately there was a series of unfortunate, labelling mistakes, ¹⁰ which were only discovered after the show. It was beautifully grown by Colin and Karen. Experienced growers commented that this was by far the best flowering they had ever seen.

This was a very eyecatching, bright apple green miniature with a very bold labellum, with a crisp white background and a bold red barring. It had 3 upright flower spikes with 18, 12 and 10 flowers. It's breeding is interesting, coming from the mating of the well known Gentle Touch “Bon Bon” and Ovation. The flowers were much smaller than both parents.

Champion Specimen – O’Beaston “Brownie”

This was a multi spiking intermediate, with lots of very well shaped brownish red blooms, with very good shape. It had a very attractive label-lum, with a distinctive, bold white pollen cap. This plant comes from the mating of Khan Flame (big, upright spikes), and Last Tango, an intermediate sized decorative (dangler).
